Basic Module Check

- Check unit drain position for match to bathroom drain location.
- Check unit for surface damage.
- Check unit color for coordination to other bathroom fixtures.
- Check unit for specified optional items and/or packages.

Alcove floor <u>MUST</u> BE LEVEL and FREE OF ALL DEBRIS!




Installation & Product Warranty

SPECIAL INSTALLATION NOTE:

- The minimal threshold shower stall design does not require a recessed alcove floor.
- CLEAN UP ALL debris from area before install begins.
- Note, the drain opening must be a 12 inch x 12 inch cutout.
- Alcove Front to Back and Left to Right MUST BE LEVEL to ensure proper drainage.








- Before placing the unit in the framed alcove, using a toothed trowel, spread a ¼" layer of mastic or construction adhesive around the drain cutout, extending out to the perimeter of the alcove area.
- Install the drain fitting to the drain opening of the unit. DO NOT STAND THE SHOWER UNIT ON THE DRAIN FITTING!
- The front floor flange support block can now be removed to position the unit.








- The floor drain cutout for a minimal threshold shower must be large enough to allow the shower floor to retain the designed continuous slope to the drain.
- A proper installation will fill only the voids without creating unwanted upward distortion in the designed floor slope required for proper drainage.








- Position the unit directly on the support material checking for proper drain fitting and drainpipe alignment.
- Confirm the threshold and floor mounting flange are resting flush on the floor.
- Confirm the unit is level along each side, across the threshold and across the drain.







- The use of a shims behind the nailing flange may be required to ensure the unit remains square.
- Protect the shower floor surface and apply weight on top of the drain until support material cures.
- FAILURE TO PROPERLY WEIGHT CENTER WILL CAUSE UNIT TO HOLD WATER!







FINAL NOTES

Final install inspection and surface care

- Please refer to the complete model installations for specific framing guidelines as well as other details.
- Check for proper drainage after install.
- Check and Clean unit after install.
 - Construction Adhesive: Soften adhesive with a handheld hair dryer and peel off adhesive. (Caution is advised when using any electrical device near water.)
 - For adhesive residue, apply rubbing alcohol or nail polish remover, full strength. (Rinse surface thoroughly)
