

## Care & Cleaning

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### Surface Care & Cleaning

Through routine use the surface can collect residues from soap, bath additives and natural body oils. Additional deposits can also collect from minerals or particles found in the water. After each use, wipe the excess water from the unit. This practice will reduce the buildup of deposits and help maintain the natural unit lustre.

Following a thorough surface cleaning, an application of quality automotive wax will help reduce major accumulations. The actual schedule for cleaning and waxing will depend on unit usage and water quality.

**WARNING! - NEVER USE ABRASIVE MATERIALS OR ABRASIVE CLEANERS ON THE UNIT SURFACE OR WHIRLPOOL TRIM (jets, air controls, and suction cover)!! NEVER APPLY WAX TO THE FLOOR!**

**EXTREME CAUTION is urged regarding the use of any cleaner, acid or solvent on the unit surface. READ AND FOLLOW PACKAGE INSTRUCTIONS FOR ALL PURCHASED CLEANING PRODUCTS!**

- ◆ **Routine Cleaning:** Mild, non-abrasive cleaner specifically formulated for and acrylic surfaces recommended. (Rinse surface thoroughly)
- ◆ **Heavy Soap Deposits:** Liquid ammonia household cleaner, applied full strength. (Rinse surface thoroughly)
- ◆ **Stubborn Stains:** Liquid household cleaner or hydrogen peroxide applied full strength. Place a clean saturated rag directly on stain and let stand several hours. (Rinse surface thoroughly)
- ◆ **Hard Water Scales:** Liquid scale remover or white vinegar, applied full strength. (Rinse surface thoroughly)
- ◆ **Mold/Mildew:** Liquid mildew remover or baking soda and water paste. Apply paste and allow to fizz several minutes. (Rinse surface thoroughly)
- ◆ **Construction Adhesive:** Soften with a hand held hair dryer and peel off adhesive. For adhesive residue, apply rubbing alcohol or nail polish remover, full strength. (Rinse surface thoroughly) (Caution is advised when using any electrical device near water.)

### Whirlpool & Air System Care & Cleaning

Through normal usage, your Oasis whirlpool and air systems can accumulate residue from soap, bath additives and natural body oils. Additional residue can also collect from minerals found in the water. A regularly scheduled cleaning will help reduce the buildup of deposits in the system and ensure your Oasis bath maintains peak efficiency.

**EXTREME CAUTION is urged regarding the use of any cleaner, acid or solvent on the whirlpool system trim. Incorrect cleaning materials can damage the trim finish. READ AND FOLLOW PACKAGE INSTRUCTIONS FOR ALL PURCHASED CLEANING PRODUCTS!**

The following procedure is recommended to remove most deposits and avoid major accumulations inside the system piping. The actual schedule for cleaning will depend on system usage and water quality, but should not exceed 90 days.

1. Fill the tub to the top of the highest jet, or about six (6) inches deep for an air system, with lukewar water.
2. Add one (1) cup of low sudsing dishwasher detergent and run the system for 20 minutes.
3. Drain the water, refill the tub with clean water, and run the system for another 20 minutes to thoroughly rinse. After draining the rinse water from tubs equipped with a EuroAire or Revive air system, the blower will automatically start 15 minutes after the blower has shut off and 'purge' any remaining moisture from the system piping.

NOTE: Periodically sanitize the system(s) by substituting one (1) cup of household bleach in place of the low-sudsing dishwasher detergent.

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### Cleaning Agents for Gelcoat &/or Acrylic Surfaces

Product	Specific Uses	Cautions
<b>Clorox</b> Bathroom Cleaner with Teflon	Use on glazed ceramic tiles, glass shower doors, plastic, chrome, fiberglass, glazed porcelain and synthetic marble.	Do not use on natural marble, brass or varnished wood.
<b>CLR</b> Bathroom & Kitchen Cleaner	Use on plastic, ceramic tile, glass, stainless steel, faucet & shower fixtures, shower doors, fiberglass, toilet bowls and sinks.	Do not use on natural marble, or synthetic marble, mirrors, wood, colored grout, plastic laminate or fabrics.
<b>Comet</b> Spray Gel	Great for use on grout, tile (glazed and unglazed), tubs, showers, shower doors, vinyl curtains, basins, sinks, fiberglass, plastic and vinyl.	Do not use on wood, painted surfaces, marble or aluminum.
<b>Easy Off</b> BAM Grime & Lime Remover	Usage Areas: Sinks, (kitchen/bathroom), faucets, tiles, walls, tubs, outdoors, cabinets, vinyl fences, garage, tools, workbenches, vanities.	Do not use on natural marble, stone, terrazzo, polished or anodized aluminum, metallic or painted surfaces, colored grout or countertops.
<b>Gel-Gloss</b> One Step Cleaner & Polish	Gel-Gloss leaves a smooth, sealed surface that eliminates water spotting and staining. In addition to fiberglass, marble and acrylic surfaces, use Gel-Gloss on ceramic, chrome, stainless steel, porcelain, and plastic laminate surfaces.	Do not use Gel-Gloss on colored tile grout or on floor surfaces where slipperiness may be hazardous.
<b>Johnson</b> Scrubbing Bubbles Bathroom Cleaner	Effectively cleans tubs, showers, shower doors, basins, glazed ceramic tile, tile, sinks, counters, stainless steel, chrome, fixtures, fiberglass, vinyl and glazed porcelain surfaces.	Not recommended for use on acrylic, brass or natural marble.
<b>Mejier</b> Daily Shower Cleaner	Can be used on all surfaces, including tile, tub, shower curtains or doors.	Do not use on marble, brass, or varnished wood.
<b>The Works</b> Tub & Shower Cleaner	This product is formulated for modern acrylic and fiberglass finishes.	Do not use on colored grout, marble, terrazzo, glazed surfaces, chrome or polished metal finishes. May etch some porcelain, ceramic, and antique finishes.
<b>Tilex</b> Bathroom	Use on the following hard, non-porous bathroom surfaces: Glazed ceramic tile, shower doors, plastic, chrome, fiberglass, glazed porcelain and synthetic marble.	Do not use on natural marble, brass or varnished wood.
<b>Tilex</b> Mildew Root Penetrator & Remover	Works on grout, tiles, tubs, sinks, counters, shower doors, vinyl curtains, glass, plastics, no-wax floors, & windowsills.	Avoid prolonged contact with metal and old porcelain. Do not use on wood or painted surfaces.

- ◆ Use of an automotive “bug” sponge is a great alternative to abrasive scratch pads for cleaning hard, stuck-on stains.
- ◆ Following a thorough cleaning, Oasis recommends an application of an automotive grade wax to gelcoat and acrylic surfaces.

**CAUTION: Do not apply wax to the unit floor as an unsafe standing surface may occur.**
